

New order: 20-25

*(New)* Section 2.

***n. Retail establishments where large numbers of people are present but only under the following conditions: (1) customers and employees maintain a six-foot distance from other individuals, and (2) the customers or employees of the retail establishment are performing essential activities or essential functions under Executive Order 20-16;***

Former language - Shopping malls and other retail establishments where large numbers of people are present but are generally not within arm's length of one another for more than 10 minutes;

***q. Senior Centers, but only for the service of carryout or delivery of meals and only if the requirements listed below are followed:***

- 1. Preserve social distancing of six feet between individuals; and***
- 2. Cease self-service of unpackaged food or beverages, such as in salad bars, buffets, or beverage stations;***

Former language (q) – Libraries (This has been removed from 20-25)

Former language (listed under 2r) – Senior centers, but only for the service of meals and only if the requirements listed below are followed:

1. Preserve social distance of 6 feet between tables, booths, bar stools, and ordering counters; and
2. Cease self-service of unpackaged food or beverages, such as in salad bars, buffets, or beverage stations;

***r. Restaurants and bars, but only under the following conditions:***

- 1. The requirements of Executive Order 20-16 are still in effect and must be met (meaning takeout or delivery service only, no dine-in service);***
- 2. No more than ten customers may be in the building at the same time and those customers must maintain a six-foot distance from other individuals;***
- 3. The number of individuals-such as cooks or servers---operating the facility may exceed ten as long as those individuals follow appropriate safety protocols, including maintaining a six-foot distance between individuals and following other directives regarding social distancing, hygiene, and other efforts to slow the spread of COVID-19;***
- 4. Cease self-service of unpackaged food or beverages, such as in salad bars, buffets, or beverage stations;***

Former language (listed under 2s) – Restaurants and bars, but only if the requirements listed below are followed:

1. Preserve social distance of 6 feet between tables, booths, bar stools, and ordering counters; and
2. Cease self-service of unpackaged food or beverages, such as in salad bars, buffets, or beverage stations;

***s. Retail food establishments (grocery stores, convenience stores, farmer's markets);***

1. ***See Executive Order 20-16 for additional restrictions that apply to retail food establishments, including KEFF 400.6.b and 400.6.c;***

Former language (under 2t)- Retail food establishments (Grocery stores, convenience stores, farmer's markets) as long as the requirements listed below are followed:

1. Preserve social distance of 6 feet between tables, booths, bar stools, and ordering counters; and
2. Cease self-service of unpackaged food or beverages, such as in salad bars, buffets, or beverage stations;

***t. Office spaces, but only for the purpose of performing essential activities or essential functions as described and limited by Executive Order 20-16;***

Former language (previously under 2u) – Office spaces and government service centers\*
