WICHITA EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION

The Wichita Educational Foundation (WEF) is an affiliate of the Wichita Regional Chamber of Commerce. The WEF is a separate corporation and has a separate Board of Directors, bylaws and bank account. This separation ensures the WEF maintains its status as a charitable foundation. Chamber staff donate their time to provide administrative support. The WEF was formed in 1997 as a 501(c)3 corporation for the purpose of providing education and training to people in the Wichita and Sedgwick County area.

The WEF's objective is to provide education, leadership preparation and training for lifelong learning and improvement of job skills. Programming may be designed to address all ages, from kindergarten students to adults.

Current and recent examples of programs and projects funded by the WEF:

- Annual Meeting – speakers and related program components
- City to City – programming and scholarships
- Leadership Wichita – programming and scholarships
- W – a community of young professionals – programming and scholarships
- W Fund – community projects that make Wichita attractive to young, diverse talent

KEEPERS ON PARADE

Keepers on Parade is an art project established in 2015 to promote Wichita pride with 10-foot tall, hand-painted replicas of the city's iconic Keeper of the Plains statue. Keepers on Parade was started by Together Wichita and continued by the Wichita Regional Chamber of Commerce in 2022 as part of the organization's quality of place initiative. Currently, there are more than 80 fiberglass Keeper statues on display throughout Wichita. Each is unique and painted by a local artist with the approval of the Blackbear Bosin Family Foundation, who owns the rights to the original Keeper of the Plains statue.

Businesses and organizations who purchase statues collaborate with these local artists who are commissioned to transform the blank fiberglass Keepers.
