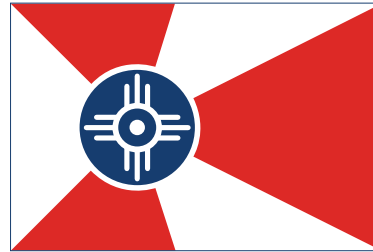
HISTORY

- Designed by local artist Cecil McAlister in a 1937 city flag contest staged by the American Legion with a cash prize from the Rotary Club
- Officially adopted on June 14, 1937 (Flag Day)
- Wichitan Mary J. Harper sewed the first 6-foot by 9-foot Wichita flag from silk.
- First flown on July 23, 1937, over the City Building, which was then located at 204 S. Main St.

SYMBOLISM



Our flag design has special meaning. The designer, Cecil McAlister, used colors and symbols to represent what he loved about Wichita.

- Red stripes = **virtue** and **honor**
- White stripes = **courage**
- Red and white stripes = **rays of light** and **freedom to come and go**
- Blue center sun = **happiness** and **faithfulness**
- White Native American design (hogan) = **permanent home**
