



Chamber/W Meeting & Event Protocols

(Revised 6/25/2020)

- If you are feeling ill or if you have been around anyone who was ill, please attend our meetings/events virtually.
- Masks required by all participants at Chamber sanctioned meetings and events. Gathering locations will be set up for social distancing. Virtual options will be provided where possible.
- Masks must be worn by Chamber staff or volunteers checking in participants and while attending ribbon cuttings.
- We are following KDHE guidelines for travel so refer to their web site for required 14-day quarantine after travel to certain locations.
- Member/Volunteer/Employee sign-in required at all meeting/events.
- Temperature will be checked at registration table with forehead scanner. If over 100 degrees, participant has a choice to take again or leave and attend meeting/event virtually. If temperature is over 100 degrees on the second check participant will be asked to leave and attend virtually.
- Hand Sanitizer, gloves and masks supplied at meeting/events. Ask all participants to bring their own masks if possible.
- Buffets only allowed if catering staff serves. Prepackaged meals/snacks preferred. Water bottles will be available.
